ORDER

17 This action is before the Court on remand from the United States Court of
18 Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. Counsel for the Gonzalez Plaintiffs, the ITCA Plaintiffs
19 and the Defendants (“the Parties”) have conferred to determine what further actions are
20 necessary. The Parties are in agreement that the decision of the Ninth Circuit Court of
21 Appeals in *Gonzalez v. Arizona*, 677 F.3d 383 (9th Cir. 2012), requires injunctive relief
22 against the application of A.R.S § 16-166(f) as applied to the Federal Form for Voter
23 Registration under the National Voter Registration Act.

25 Accordingly,

26
27 IT IS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

28 1. Effective as of this date, Defendants shall not reject Federal Forms from

1 those who seek to register to vote for the reason that they have not provided proof of
2 citizenship under A.R.S § 16-166(f).

3 2. The parties shall brief the Court concerning the terms of any subsequent
4 order according to the following schedule:

5 **July 13, 2012** – Plaintiffs’ opening briefs (ten pages each) are due;

6 **July 19, 2012** – Defendants’ response briefs (ten pages if


7 separate, or seventeen pages if combined) are due;

8 **July 24, 2012** – Plaintiffs’ reply briefs (five pages each) are due.

9 3. In the event that this Court’s final judgment issues before the Supreme
10 Court’s disposition of the Defendants’ petition for *certiorari*, any application for
11 attorneys’ fees shall be due within thirty days following the Supreme Court’s
12 determination.

15 4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this Order, to
16 address the matters raised by the Parties in their briefs filed pursuant to this Order, and
17 to award such further relief as is required by the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals’ decision
18 in *Gonzalez v. Arizona*, 677 F.3d 383 (9th Cir. 2012).
