
Map of Shame 2014



Map of Shame Index

The states colored red on the Map of Shame indicate states in which restrictive voting laws have passed or being actively considered by that state's legislature or will be on a ballot referendum in 2014. The list does not contain every restrictive bill introduced in 2014 only those that have been considered by committee.

- AL: Proof of citizenship (state announced it will proceed with implementation)
- AR: Photo ID (in effect & currently challenged in court)
- AZ: Proof of Citizenship (currently challenged in court)
- GA: Photo ID (in effect), Proof of citizenship
- KS: Photo ID (in effect), Proof of Citizenship (in effect for state registration & currently challenged in court)
- IN: Photo ID (in effect)
- MO: Considering photo ID law
- MS: Photo ID (in effect)
- MT: Elimination of same day registration on 2014 ballot referendum
- NC: Reduction of early voting, elimination of same day registration, photo ID (ID requirement is NOT in effect for 2014, all voting law changes currently challenged in court)
- OH: Reduction of early voting days, elimination of same day registration (signed by Governor)
- PA: Photo ID law passed (court ruled unconstitutional, not in effect)
- TN: Photo ID (in effect)
- TX: Photo ID (in effect & currently challenged in court)
- VA: Photo ID (in effect)
- WI: Photo ID law passed (blocked by litigation, not in effect), cuts to early voting (signed by Governor)
