## **Employment Discrimination!**

### What Is Employment Discrimination?

- Employment Discrimination can occur in hiring, promotion, job assignment, termination and wages.
- References to where you are from, your ancestry, ethnicity, accent, religion, appearance, the way you dress, and even your name can be signals of national origin discrimination.

### What Are My Rights?

- Everyone has a **right to equal treatment** in their workplace.
- Workers have a right to report what they think is illegal discrimination. It is illegal for an employer to take action, such as firing an employee who has filed a complaint.

### What Should I Do?

Write down details of discrimination and harassment in your workplace and report it to people close to you, people with authority in the company, and/or to one of the resources below.
